1. **Scope of work:** Detailed in Work schedule.
2. **Quantity:** Detailed in Work schedule.
3. **Price:** Lumpsum amount for the entire work shall be quoted.
4. **Period:** The work should be completed within **Forty Five Days** from the date of issue of Work Order.
5. The tenderer should have **valid ESI, and P.F, MSME registration** if applicable for participating in the tender.
6. The quantity mentioned in the work schedule is approximate and no extra claims are admissible due to any variation in quantity. The bidder should visit the site and assess the work before quoting.
7. **Pre Qualification Criteria:**
 - i.) Should be a licensed Contractor who is having experience in executing pipeline works of diameter 150 mm and above.
 - ii.) Work Orders showing the details shall be considered for evaluation
 - iii.) Sub Contract will not be considered for evaluation
8. In support of this, tenderer should submit the **copy of such work orders.**
9. The line alteration work after earthwork tar cutting etc should be done within 1 day in such a way that company should not face shortage of water.
10. All the materials required for the successful completion of the work is under the scope of the contractor.

11. All statutory approvals for Tar cutting, changing the existing line, connecting the existing line with KWA – JNNURM line should be taken by the contractor and the copy of the same should be submitted in TTPL.
12. The pipelines and materials used for the work should be as per the specification of KWA.
13. Statutory payments if any should be submitted by the contractor.
14. The contractor has to supply as many specialized workers and necessary tools and tackles based on the urgency of work as mentioned by Engineer-in-charge and the work has to be completed within the time limit.
15. The company is no way responsible for any loss or damage to the materials entered in TTPL campus by the contractor.
16. All the balance materials should be removed and cleared the work site at the end of every day. The work site must be cleaned before submitting the bill.
17. Payment will be made after satisfactory completion of the work with the recommendation of the officer in charge. Contractor shall submit Entry Pass issued from Main Gate along with the bills.
18. 10% of the work order amount will be hold as retention and this will be released after a period of six months of completion of work.
19. It is entirely the contractor's responsibility to provide all safety equipments wherever necessary to their workmen. The Company is in no way responsible for any injury, disability or death of contractor's workmen due to non-compliance of safety regulations.
20. TTPL reserves the right to accept / reject any of the tender after evaluation with or without assigning reason no matter whether a Tenderer has quoted the lowest rate. All questions/disputes arising out of or in connection with this shall be decided by the Managing Director of the company and his decision thereof shall be final and binding to all tenderers.
21. Bids should bear the signature of the bidder in all pages of tender document and work schedule.
22. Tenders without remitting EMD and Tender cost will be rejected
23. Conditional Bids shall not be considered
24. **The rate quoted shall be exclusive of GST and the % of GST applicable should be mentioned at the space provided in the price pro forma. If the bidder is below the**

No subsequent claim will be entertained.**

25. It is no binding on the company to accept the lowest offer. The company reserves the right to cancel/postpone the tender or to reject any or all offers without assigning any reason.
26. The tenderer should remit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) mentioned in this document in cash/DD and proof of thereof should be enclosed along with the tender. Other mode of remittance will not be accepted.
27. If any irregularity or fraudulent behavior is noticed on part of the contractor / his agents / representatives or the crew of the vehicle engaged by the contractor for the performance of the contract, the company reserves the right to take all suitable action deemed fit against the contractor and those concerned.
28. The contractor will be responsible for meeting all the requirements of the various labour enactments applicable from time to time and should indemnify and keep indemnified the company against all losses and damages sustained by the company in this regard at all times.
29. Contractor should comply with all relevant formalities under contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1971, such as display of rate of wages, date, place and time of payment of wages, date of payment of unpaid wages etc. they should also intimate the time, date and place of disbursement of wages to the supervisory Officer nominated under the above act for certification of payment to contract workers.
30. Crawling boards and safety belts are to be provided to contract labourers working at roof top and high elevation. Workmen using such equipment alone will be permitted to work at such elevated position. The contractor should strictly adhere to the Safety Rules prevailing in the company failing which penalty are decided will be imposed. It is entirely the contractor's responsibility to provide all safety equipment wherever necessary to their workmen. The Company is in no way responsible for any injury, disability or death of contractor's workmen due to non-compliance of safety regulations.
31. The contractor should fix a display board on the materials of their own kept within the Company premises indicating the names of the contractor and work order No.

32. The Company reserves the right to cancel the work order forfeiting security deposit if the work is not started within 10 days from the date of receipt of work order and also to terminate the contract at any time if the work is not done with proportionate progress to the satisfaction of the company officials and in all such cases the company will be at liberty to get the work done in any manner that the company thinks fits and all losses and damage sustain by the company in this regard will be recovered from contractor and his assets.
33. Canteen charges will be deducted from the contractor's bill as per rules.
34. The work should be completed within the time limit stipulated in the work schedule. 0.5% of the contract amount will be levied per week for delay on your part as liquidated damages, subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract value.
35. **Validity of rates:** The quoted rate must be valid for a period for 90 days from the date of opening of the tender and till the completion of the work if the contract is awarded.
36. **Guarantee:** The tenderer should also provide a guarantee for six months against poor workmanship. 10% of the contract amount will be retained by the company during the guarantee period.
37. **Security Deposit :** The successful Tenderer should remit 3% of the contract value as security Deposit immediately from the date of issue of work order. The security deposit will not carry any interest and will be refunded after the completion of all contractual obligations .On default of the tenderer to remit the Security Deposit and sign the Agreement, the EMD withstand forfeited and if any loss or damage is sustained by the company in this regard, the same will also be recovered from him.
38. **Performance Agreement:** The contractor should execute an agreement on stamp paper worth Rs.200/- immediately from the date of remittance of Security Deposit and start work after remitting the SD.
39. **Jurisdiction:** Any legal proceeding or suit against the Company arising out of or in connection with the tender shall be filed or instituted in a court having jurisdiction in the city of Thiruvanthapuram, Kerala.
40. **Liquidated damages:** In case of any delay in the execution of the Order beyond the stipulated date of work schedule including any extension permitted in writing, the TTPL reserves right to recover from the contractor a sum equivalent to 0.5% of the total value of the delay for each week of delay and part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the total value of the Order. Alternatively, the Company reserves the right to execute the work from elsewhere at the sole risk and cost of the contractor and recover all such extra cost incurred by the company in execution of work by the above procedure.
41. All statutory deductions will be made from the contractor's bill as per rules.

42. All workers engaged with the work shall have Police Clearance Certificate (PCC) and other formalities insisted by Security Department of TTPL.
43. In case of any matters pertaining to this Tender which are not incorporated /specified there in, in such cases guidelines of CVC/Kerala store Purchase Manual shall be applicable.
